11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 23.1-2209 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of
13	Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 4 of Title 23.1 a section numbered 23.1-411 as follows:
14	§ 23.1-411. Enrolled students; campus housing.
15	Except in the case of students participating in a Reserve Officers' Training Corps program on
16	campus or students enrolled at the Virginia Military Institute, no student enrolled at a public institution
17	of higher education shall be required to live in a campus housing facility.
18	§ 23.1-2209. Powers and duties.
19	A. The board shall (i) care for and preserve all property belonging to the University; (ii) grant to the
20 21	president of the University supreme administrative direction over all the schools, colleges, divisions, and
21	branches of the University; and (iii) examine the progress of the students in each year and give to those
22 23	who excel in any course of study such honors as it deems proper.
	B. The board may (i) remove the president of the University or any professor with the assent of
24 25	two-thirds of its members; (ii) prescribe the duties of each professor and the course and mode of instruction; (iii) appoint a comptroller and proctor and employ any other agent or servant; (iv)
