11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 32.1-283.7 as follows:
12	§ 32.1-283.7. Investigation of deaths involving Sudden Unexpected Death in Epilepsy; protocol;
13	information; training.
14	A. The Chief Medical Examiner shall develop protocols for the investigation of deaths of individuals
15	with seizure disorders to ensure the proper identification of deaths resulting from Sudden Unexpected
16 17	Death in Epilepsy (SUDEP). B. In any case involving a finding of death resulting from SUDEP, within 30 days of such finding
18	the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner shall notify the North American SUDEP Registry at the New
19	York University Langone Medical Center that the death has occurred and shall provide to the next of
20	kin of the deceased, if known, information regarding the benefits of and process for (i) submitting the
21	deceased's medical information, including information about the deceased's history of epilepsy and
22	seizures, to the North American SUDEP Registry and (ii) donating the deceased's blood, brain, and
23	heart for the purpose of scientific study.
24 25	C. The Chief Medical Examiner shall develop, together with the Commissioner, training for medical examiners on SUDEP and the proper identification of deaths resulting from SUDEP and shall require

26 every medical examiner appointed pursuant to § 32.1-282 to receive such training annually.
