- 2 3 4 5 6 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-328.2 [ and to repeal 7 § 46.2-345.1 of the Code of Virginia, ] relating to Department of Motor Vehicles documents; veteran 8 indicator.
- 9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-328.2 as follows: 10 11

§ 46.2-328.2. Department to issue documents; veteran indicator. A. For the purposes of this section, "veteran" means (i) a Virginia resident who has served in the 12 active military, naval, or air service and whose final discharge or release therefrom was under 13 honorable conditions or (ii) a Virginia resident who has served honorably for greater than 180 days in 14 15 the Virginia National Guard or the United States Armed Forces Reserves.

B. In cooperation with the Department of Veterans Services and the Department of Military Affairs, 16 17 the Department shall issue driver's licenses, permits, and identification cards displaying an indicator that the holder is a veteran to applicants who request such endorsement and provide proof of such 18 19 veteran status.

20 C. The Department shall charge the same fee for any document issued pursuant to this section as is 21 charged for the same document issued without the veteran indicator. No additional fee shall be charged 22 for the veteran indicator.

23 D. Any documentation issued pursuant to this section shall not be used for determination of any federal benefit. 24

2. That § 46.2-345.1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed. 25
