That § 45.1-270.7 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 45.1-270.7. Coal Surface Mining Reclamation Fund Advisory Committee continued as Coal 12 13 Surface Mining Reclamation Fund Advisory Board. A. The Coal Surface Mining Reclamation Fund Advisory Committee is continued and shall hereafter 14 15 be known as the Coal Surface Mining Reclamation Fund Advisory Board. The Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall consist of five seven members appointed by the Governor subject to confirmation 16 by the General Assembly, three four of whom shall represent the coal industry, one of whom shall be a 17 representative of the Director, one of whom shall represent conservation interests, and one of whom 18 shall be a member of the public without any coal industry interests. The Commissioner Director of the 19 20 Division shall be a continuing ex officio nonvoting member of the Reclamation Fund Advisory Board 21 and shall serve as Secretary thereto. B. The voting members of the Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall initially be appointed for 22 23 terms of one, two, three, four, and five years, such terms to be assigned by lot. Thereafter, all members 24 shall be appointed for five-year terms. No person shall serve more than two consecutive terms. 25 C. The Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall annually elect a chairman and shall formulate rules 26 for its organization and procedure. 27 D. The voting members of the Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall serve without compensation 28 or reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. 29 E. The Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall meet not less than twice each year for the purpose of 30 formulating recommendations to the Director concerning oversight of the general operation of the Fund. 31 The Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall report biannually to the Director and to the Governor on the status of the Fund and shall recommend to the Director regulations or changes thereto for the 32 33 administration or operation of the Fund. The Director, in his discretion, may adopt the recommendations of the Reclamation Fund Advisory Board through regulatory action from time to time in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 19 (§ 45.1-226 et seq.) of this title and otherwise in accordance with law. 34 35 36 F. The Reclamation Fund Advisory Board shall serve as the advisory body required by Article V of 37 the Interstate Mining Compact (§ 45.1-271).
