9 10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 63.2-1734 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 63.2-1734. Regulations for child welfare agencies.
13	A. The Board shall adopt regulations for the activities, services and facilities to be employed by
14	persons and agencies required to be licensed under this subtitle, which shall be designed to ensure that
15	such activities, services and facilities are conducive to the welfare of the children under the custody or
16	control of such persons or agencies.
17	Such regulations shall be developed in consultation with representatives of the affected entities and
18	shall include, but need not be limited to, matters relating to the sex, age, and number of children and
19	other persons to be maintained, cared for, or placed out, as the case may be, and to the buildings and
20	premises to be used, and reasonable standards for the activities, services and facilities to be employed.
21	Such limitations and standards shall be specified in each license and renewal thereof. Such regulations
22 23	shall not require the adoption of a specific teaching approach or doctrine or require the membership,
23 24	affiliation or accreditation services of any single private accreditation or certification agency. Such regulations shall not prohibit child day programs providing care for school-age children at a
25	location that is currently approved by the Department of Education or recognized as a private school by
<b>2</b> 6	the State Board of Education for school occupancy and that houses a public or private school during the
27	school year from permitting school-age children to use outdoor play equipment and areas approved for
28	use by students of the school during school hours.
29	B. The Board shall adopt or amend regulations, policies and procedures related to child day care in
30	collaboration with the Virginia Recreation and Park Society. No regulation adopted by the Board shall
31	prohibit a child day center from hiring an armed security officer, licensed pursuant to Article 4
32	(§ 9.1-138 et seq.) of Chapter 1 of Title 9.1, to provide protection for children placed in the care of the
33	child day center or employees of the center. The Board shall adopt or amend regulations related to
34	therapeutic recreation programs in collaboration with the Virginia Park and Recreation Society and the
35	Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services.

The Board shall establish a Quality Rating and Improvement System for all child welfare agencies participating in the Virginia Preschool Initiative.
