6 7	A BILL to amend and reenact § 2.2-2699.3 of the Code of Virginia, to amend and reenact the second amendment of Chapter 444 of the Acts of Assembly of 2008, and to amend and reenact the third
8	enactment of Chapter 818 and the third enactment of Chapter 852 of the Acts of Assembly of 2009,
9	relating to appointments to Broadband Advisory Council; expiration of the Office of Telework
10	Promotion and Broadband Assistance and the Broadband Advisory Council.
11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 2.2-2699.3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 2.2-2699.3. (Expires July 1, 2018) Broadband Advisory Council; purpose; membership;
14	compensation; chairman.
15	A. The Broadband Advisory Council (the Council) is established as an advisory council, within the
16	meaning of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Council shall be
17 18	to advise the Governor on policy and funding priorities to expedite deployment and reduce the cost of
10 19	broadband access in the Commonwealth. B. The Council shall have a total membership of 14 18 members that shall consist of six eight
20	legislative members, four six nonlegislative citizen members, and four ex officio members. Members
21	shall be appointed as follows: four members of the House of Delegates to be appointed by the Speaker
22	of the House of Delegates in accordance with the principles of proportional representation contained in
23	the Rules of the House of Delegates; two four members of the Senate to be appointed by the Senate
24	Committee on Rules; and four six nonlegislative citizen members to be appointed by the Governor, of
25	whom one shall be a representative of the Virginia Cable Telecommunications Association, one shall be
26	a representative of the Virginia Telecommunications Industry Association, one shall be a representative
27 28	from local government recommended by the Virginia Municipal League and Virginia Association of
20 29	Counties, and one shall be a representative of the Virginia, Maryland and Delaware Association of <i>Electric Cooperatives</i> , one shall be a representative of the Virginia Wireless Internet Service Providers
3 0	Association, and one shall be a representative of a municipal broadband authority. The Secretaries of
31	Administration, Agriculture and Forestry, and Commerce and Trade, and Technology, or their designees,
32	and the executive director of the Center for Rural Virginia shall serve ex officio. Legislative and ex
33	officio members shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office. Other members shall be
34	appointed for terms of two years. Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term,
35	shall be for the unexpired terms. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original
36 37	appointments. All members may be reappointed.
37 38	C. Legislative members of the Council shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12. Nonlegislative citizen members shall serve without compensation. All members shall be reimbursed for
39	all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in
40	§§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. Funding for compensation and expenses of legislative members shall be
41	provided by the operating budgets of the Clerk of the House of Delegates and the Clerk of the Senate
42	upon approval of the Joint Rules Committee. Funding for the costs of expenses of the nonlegislative
43	citizen members and all other expenses of the Council shall be provided by the Office of the Secretary
44	of Technology.
45	D. The Council shall elect a chairman and a vice-chairman annually from among its membership. A
46	majority of the members shall constitute a quorum. The Council shall meet at such times as may be
47 48	called by the chairman or a majority of the Council. E. Staff to the Council shall be provided by the Office of Telework Promotion and Broadband
49	Assistance. The Division of Legislative Services shall provide additional staff support to legislative
50	members serving on the Council.
51	2. That the second enactment of Chapter 444 of the Acts of Assembly of 2008 is amended and
52	reenacted as follows:
