10	WHEREAS, the overuse and abuse of prescription opioid painkillers has become a national and
11	statewide crisis; and
12 13	WHEREAS, drug overdose is the leading cause of accidental death in the United States, with 52,404
13	lethal drug overdoses in 2015; and WHEREAS, opioid addiction is driving this epidemic, with 20,101 overdose deaths related to
15	opioid-based prescription pain relievers in 2015; and
16	WHEREAS, dozens of people continue to die each day from the abuse of prescription opioids like
17	oxycodone, hydrocodone, methadone, and fentanyl, and a majority of heroin users report using
18	prescription opioids prior to heroin; and
19	WHEREAS, prescription opioids are often recommended for the management of lower back, neck,
20	and musculoskeletal pain; more than 100 million Americans suffer from chronic pain, and 75 to 85
21 22	percent of Americans will experience some form of back pain in their lifetime; and WHEREAS, chiropractic care and other drug-free forms of health care and pain management must
23	play a major role in helping to ease the immense burden of this crisis; and
24	WHEREAS, chiropractors are trained and educated to effectively address spinal and musculoskeletal
25	conditions with nonsurgical, evidence-based, and drug-free pain management; chiropractic care yields
26	improved clinical outcomes, reduced costs, and high levels of patient satisfaction; and
27	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth has been hit hard by this epidemic, and the Virginia Department of
28	Health has made it a high priority to combat this health emergency carefully and comprehensively; now,
29	therefore, be it
30 31	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate September, in 2018 and in each succeeding year, as Drug-free Pain Management Awareness Month in
31 32	Virginia; and, be it
33	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution
34	to the Unified Virginia Chiropractic Association so that members of the organization may be apprised of
35	the sense of the General Assembly of Virginia in this matter; and, be it
36	RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates post the designation of this month
37	on the General Assembly's website.
