6 WHEREAS, Bishop Kim W. Brown, pastor of Mount Lebanon Missionary Baptist Church, was 7 named the 2017 First Citizen of Chesapeake for his spiritual leadership and commitment to community 8 service; and

9 WHEREAS, the First Citizen of Chesapeake award is presented annually by the Rotary Club of 10 Chesapeake to recognize local leaders who have made exceptional contributions to the community and exemplify the organization's motto "Service Above Self"; and 11

WHEREAS, after earning a bachelor's degree from Norfolk State University and master's and 12 13 doctoral degrees from the Samuel D. Proctor School of Theology of Virginia Union University, Kim Brown joined Mount Lebanon Missionary Baptist Church in 1990, at a time when the congregation was 14 15 only about 75 people; and

WHEREAS, a visionary with a creative approach to ministry, Kim Brown helped the Mount Lebanon 16 Missionary Baptist Church community grow to more than 13,000 members, with branch churches in 17 Newport News and Elizabeth City and Charlotte, North Carolina; and 18

19 WHEREAS, Kim Brown has built close relationships with his fellow clergy, local leaders, and 20 members of the community; he has served on the Chesapeake Hospital Authority for more than a 21 decade, including a term as chair in 2008; and

WHEREAS, Kim Brown has received numerous other awards and accolades, including recognition 22 23 from the L.D. Britt, M.D., Scholarship Fund, Elizabeth City State University, and the Urban League of 24 Hampton Roads; and

25 WHEREAS, Kim Brown enjoys the love and support of his wife, Valerie, and their children, James 26 and Kimberly; he and his wife founded K. W. Brown International Ministries, Inc., furthering their 27 commitment to fruitful, life-changing ministry; and

28 WHEREAS, Kim Brown was presented with the prestigious First Citizen of Chesapeake award at a 29 banquet on September 21, 2017, at the Chesapeake Conference Center; now, therefore, be it

30 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 31 commend Bishop Kim W. Brown on being named as the 2017 First Citizen of Chesapeake; and, be it
