8 WHEREAS, in 2017, an estimated 300 women answered the call and ran for public office in the 9 Commonwealth for positions ranging from local to statewide; and

10 WHEREAS, women candidates made historic gains across the Commonwealth, as evidenced in the 11 House of Delegates where, at the beginning of the 2018 Session of the General Assembly, women held 12 a record-breaking 28 percent of the seats; and
