13	general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
14	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely:
15 16	Amend Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of Virginia as follows: ARTICLE V
10 17	EXECUTIVE
18	Section 2. Election of Governor and Lieutenant Governor.
19	The Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall be elected by the qualified voters of the
20	Commonwealth at the time and place of choosing members of the General Assembly. The names of the
21	candidates for Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall appear jointly on the ballot at the general
22 23	<i>election, and the voters shall cast a single vote applicable to both offices.</i> Returns of the election shall be transmitted, under seal, by the proper officers, to the State Board of
23 24	Elections, or such other officer or agency as may be designated by law, which shall cause the returns to
25	be opened and the votes to be counted in the manner prescribed by law. The person persons having the
26	highest number of votes cast jointly for them shall be declared elected; but if two or more pairs of
27	candidates shall have the highest and an equal number of votes, one of them shall be chosen Governor
28	and Lieutenant Governor by a majority of the total membership of the General Assembly. Contested
