8 WHEREAS, a native of Allendale, South Carolina, Wanda Mitchell worked in higher education for
9 more than 30 years, finishing her career as an affiliate professor in the Department of Counseling and
10 Special Education at Virginia Commonwealth University; and

11 WHEREAS, Wanda Mitchell gave years of dedicated service to various specialized organizations, 12 including serving on the Board of Directors of the National Association of Diversity Officers in Higher 13 Education, on the Association of Public and Land-grant Universities' Commission on Access, Diversity 14 and Excellence, and as faculty for the Higher Education Resources Services Leadership Institute; and

WHEREAS, Wanda Mitchell volunteered with many church and civic organizations and served on
community boards; she was a member of the Virginia Center for Inclusive Communities, Side by Side,
Leadership Metro Richmond, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.; and

18 WHEREAS, in 2001, Wanda Mitchell graduated from the Grace E. Harris Leadership Institute for
 19 Women in Higher Education and Faith-Based Organizations, and she received several other awards and
 20 professional accolades; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, Wanda Mitchell served as a faculty member at the University of New
 Hampshire, holding the title of chief diversity officer; and

WHEREAS, Wanda Mitchell served as the founding vice president for inclusive excellence and
 served as the founding chief diversity officer at Virginia Commonwealth University from 2012 to 2015;
 and

WHEREAS, Wanda Mitchell is survived by her father, John E. Tilley; her two sisters, Bunita Tilley
and Lisa D. Tilley; her brother Dennis R. Patterson; and a large and loving family; now, therefore, be it
