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11	WHEREAS, under Article VIII, Section 1 of the Constitution of Virginia, ultimate responsibility for
12	public education rests with the General Assembly, which is specifically charged with the duties of
13	establishing a public school system and striving to ensure its quality; and
14	WHEREAS, the Standards of Quality, prescribed by the Board of Education and revised only by the
15	General Assembly, establish minimum educational goals and requirements; and
16	WHEREAS, the cost of such Standards of Quality and how that cost is shared between the state and
17	the localities is determined by the General Assembly; and
18	WHEREAS, the Standards of Quality funding formula has undergone several changes in the past
19	decade and may no longer reflect the actual costs schools face in educating Virginia's children; and
20	WHEREAS, the General Assembly must take into account the actual cost of education in the
21	Commonwealth in order to ensure a high quality education program and a fair balance of costs between
22	the state and the localities; now, therefore, be it
23	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Joint Legislative Audit and
24	Review Commission be directed to study the true cost of education in the Commonwealth and provide
25	an accurate assessment of the costs to implement the Standards of Quality.
26	In conducting its study, the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) shall (i)
27	estimate the cost of implementing the Standards of Quality based on the actual expense of education
28	prevailing in the Commonwealth; (ii) analyze changes in the Standards of Quality funding formula since
29	2009 and the impact of such changes on its accuracy in reflecting such costs; (iii) recommend changes
30	to the Standards of Quality funding formula to ensure that state support is neither inadequate nor
31	excessive; and (iv) consider any other funding issues and make any other recommendations it deems
32	relevant.
33	Technical assistance shall be provided to the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission by the
34	Department of Education. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to JLARC for this
35	study, upon request.
36	The Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission shall complete its meetings for the first year by
37	November 30, 2018, and for the second year by November 30, 2019, and the Director shall submit to
38	the Division of Legislative Automated Systems an executive summary of its findings and
39	recommendations no later than the first day of the next Regular Session of the General Assembly for
40	each year. Each executive summary shall state whether the Joint Legislative Audit and Review
41	Commission intends to submit to the General Assembly and the Governor a report of its findings and
42	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summaries and reports
43	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
44	the processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's
45	website.

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
