 admiration of her colleagues; and

18 WHEREAS, since her well-earned retirement from firefighting, Martina Campbell has pursued a new19 passion by enrolling in Stratford University to study culinary arts, baking, and pastries; and

 protect the residents of Suffolk; her strength, bravery, and devotion to duty make her an exemplary role
