10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 19.2-188.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 19.2-188.1. Testimony regarding identification of controlled substances.
12	A. In any preliminary hearing on a violation of Article 1 (§ 18.2-247 et seq.) of Chapter 7 of Title
13	18.2 or a violation of subdivision 6 of § 53.1-203, any law-enforcement officer shall be permitted to
15	testify as to the results of field tests that have been approved by the Department of Forensic Science
16	pursuant to regulations adopted in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.),
17	regarding whether or not any substance the identity of which is at issue in such hearing is a controlled
18	substance, imitation controlled substance, or marijuana, as defined in § 18.2-247.
19	B. In any trial for a violation of subdivision (a) (1) of § 18.2-248.1 or § 18.2-250.1, any
20	law-enforcement officer shall be permitted to testify as to the results of any marijuana field test
21	approved as accurate and reliable by the Department of Forensic Science pursuant to regulations adopted
22	in accordance with the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), regarding whether or not any
23	plant material, the identity of which is at issue, is marijuana, provided <i>that</i> the defendant has been given
24	written notice of his right to request a full chemical analysis. Such notice shall be on a form approved
25	by the Supreme Court and shall be provided to the defendant prior to trial.
26	In any case in which the person accused of a violation of subdivision (a) (1) of § 18.2-248.1 or
27	§ 18.2-250.1, or the attorney of record for the accused, desires a full chemical analysis of the alleged
28	plant material, he may, by motion prior to trial before the court in which the charge is pending, request
29 20	such a chemical analysis. Upon such motion, the court shall order that the analysis be performed by the
30	Department of Forensic Science and shall prescribe in its order the method of custody, transfer, and
