12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 4.1-103.02 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 4.1-103.02. Additional powers; substance abuse prevention; Virginia Institutions of Higher
13	Education Substance Use Advisory Committee established.
15	It shall be the responsibility of the Board to administer a substance abuse prevention program within
16	the Commonwealth and to (i) coordinate substance abuse prevention activities of agencies of the
17	Commonwealth in such program, (ii) review substance abuse prevention program expenditures by
18	agencies of the Commonwealth, and (iii) determine the direction and appropriateness of such
19	expenditures. The Board shall cooperate with federal, state, and local agencies, private and public
20	agencies, interested organizations, and individuals in order to prevent substance abuse within the
21	Commonwealth. The Board shall report annually by December 1 of each year to the Governor and the
22	General Assembly on the substance abuse prevention activities of the Commonwealth.
23	The Board shall also establish and appoint members to the Virginia Institutions of Higher Education
24	Substance Use Advisory Committee (Advisory Committee). The goal of the Advisory Committee shall be
25	to develop and update a statewide strategic plan for substance use education, prevention, and
26 27	intervention at Virginia's public and private institutions of higher education. The strategic plan shall (a)
27 28	incorporate the use of best practices, which may include, but not be limited to, student-led peer-to-peer education and college or other institutions of higher education recovery programs; (b) provide for the
20 29	collection of statewide data from all institutions of higher education recovery programs, (b) provide for the collection of statewide data from all institutions of higher education on student alcohol and substance
30	use; (c) assist institutions of higher education in developing their individual strategic plans by providing
31	networking and training resources and materials; and (d) develop and maintain reporting guidelines for
32	use by institutions of higher education in their individual strategic plans.
33	The Advisory Committee shall consist of representatives from Virginia's public and private

institutions of higher education, including students and directors of student health, and such other members as the Board may deem appropriate. The Advisory Committee's membership shall be broadly representative of individuals from both public and private institutions of higher education. The Advisory Committee shall submit an annual report on its activities to the Governor and the 34 35 36
