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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 22.1-181 and 46.2-339 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school bus 3 operators; training.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That §§ 22.1-181 and 46.2-339 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 22.1-181. Training program for school bus operators.

9 The Board of Education shall develop a training program for persons applying for employment, and 10 employed, to operate school buses and shall promote its implementation. For applicants not currently possessing a commercial driver's license, such regulations shall require (i) a minimum of 24 hours of 11 12 classroom training administered pursuant to this section and (ii) six hours of behind-the-wheel training 13 on a school bus that contains no pupil passengers. For applicants currently possessing a commercial driver's license, such regulations shall require (a) a minimum of four hours of classroom training 14 15 administered pursuant to this section and (b) three hours of behind-the-wheel training on a school bus that contains no pupil passengers. Behind-the-wheel training shall be administered under the direct 16 17 on-board supervision of a designated school bus driver trainer. 18

§ 46.2-339. Qualifications of school bus operators; training; examination.

19 A. No person shall drive operate any school bus on a highway in the Commonwealth unless he has had a reasonable amount of experience in driving operating motor vehicles, and has passed a special 20 21 examination pertaining to his ability to drive operate a school bus with safety to its passengers and to 22 other persons using the highways. Such person shall obtain a commercial driver's license with the 23 applicable classifications and endorsements, issued pursuant to the Virginia Commercial Driver's License 24 Act (§ 46.2-341.1 et seq.), if the school bus he drives operates is a commercial motor vehicle as defined in the Virginia Commercial Driver's License Act. For the purpose of preparing for the examination 25 26 required by this section, any person holding a valid driver's license issued under Article 4 of this 27 chapter, may drive, under the direct supervision of a person holding a valid school bus license 28 endorsement, a school bus which contains no other passengers, provided that, on and after April 1, 29 1992, only persons holding a valid commercial driver's license or instruction permit issued under the 30 provisions of the Virginia Commercial Driver's License Act, may operate, under the direct supervision of 31 a person holding a valid commercial driver's license with a school bus endorsement, a school bus which 32 that is a commercial motor vehicle as defined in the Virginia Commercial Driver's License Act and 33 which that contains no pupil passengers.

34 B. The Department may adopt regulations necessary to provide for the examination of persons 35 desiring to qualify to drive operate school buses in the Commonwealth and for the granting of permits to qualified applicants. 36

37 C. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section otherwise, no person shall drive operate any school 38 bus on a highway in the Commonwealth during any period in which he is a person for whom 39 registration with the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry is required pursuant to Chapter 9 40 (§ 9.1-900 et seq.) of Title 9.1.

41 2. That the State Board of Education and the Department of Motor Vehicles' initial adoption of 42 regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act shall be exempt from the 43 Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq. of the Code of Virginia), except that the State Board of Education and the Department of Motor Vehicles shall provide an opportunity for public 44 45 comment on the regulations prior to adoption.
