6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 3.2-6509.1, relating to disclosure
7	of animal bite history; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 3.2-6509.1 as follows:
10	§ 3.2-6509.1. Disclosure of animal bite history; penalties.
11	A. Any custodian of a releasing agency, animal control officer, law-enforcement officer, or humane
12	investigator, upon taking custody of any dog or cat in the course of his official duties, shall ask and
13	document whether, if known, the dog or cat has bitten a person or other animal and the circumstances
14	and date of such bite. Any custodian of a releasing agency, animal control officer, law-enforcement
15	officer, or humane investigator, upon release of a dog or cat for (i) adoption, (ii) return to a rightful
16	owner, or (iii) transfer to another agency, shall disclose, if known, that the dog or cat has bitten a
17	person or other animal and the circumstances and date of such bite.
18	B. Violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
