Impersonating certain public safety personnel; penalty. 12 13 Any person who willfully impersonates, with the intent to make another believe he is, an emergency medical services provider, firefighter, special forest warden designated pursuant to § 10.1-1135, fire 14 marshal, of fire chief, or member of the United States Armed Forces, Armed Forces Reserves, or 15 16 National Guard is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent offense is punishable as a Class 6 felony. 17 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 18 19

commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 836 of the Acts of Assembly of 2017 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the

Department of Juvenile Justice.
