10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 15.2-925.01 as follows:
12	§ 15.2-925.01. Regulation, etc., of attire, accessories at permitted assemblies or movement of
13	persons.
14	Any locality may pass an ordinance to regulate, restrict, or prohibit the wearing of any combination
15	of attire or weaponry commonly associated with military combat, paramilitary operations, or warfare
16	that gives a reasonable person the impression that the wearer is an on-duty member of the United States
17	Armed Forces, an official law-enforcement agency, or the militia during any permitted assembly of
18	persons or movement of persons or vehicles if such attire constitutes a threat to the public safety or
19	welfare.
20	Such regulation, restriction, or prohibition shall not apply to any active member of the United States
