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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 24.2-416.6 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 24.2-416.6. Third-party registration groups; registration, disclosure, and recordkeeping
13	requirements; compensation prohibition.
14	A. Prior to engaging in any voter registration activities, any individual or group that obtains 25 or
15	more voter registration applications from the Department of Elections, local electoral board, or general
16	registrar's office shall be required to register with the Department of Elections as a third-party
17	registration group. The Department shall issue a unique identification number to each such individual
18	or group. Persons volunteering with or employed by a third-party registration group shall also register
19	with the Department as a volunteer or employee of that group. Such group may facilitate the
20	registration of its volunteers or employees with the Department.
21	B. Each person volunteering with or employed by a third-party registration group shall be assigned
22	by the group's organizer a unique identification number, which shall be in a format approved by the
$\overline{23}$	State Board. Each group shall maintain a record of all volunteers and employees engaging in voter
24	registration activities on behalf of the group. Such record shall include the name and contact
25	information of each such person and his unique identification number. This record shall be provided to
26	the Department of Elections within five business days of the close of registration records pursuant to
27	§ 24.2-416. The record shall also be provided to the Department upon request, within three business
28	days of such request.
29	C. All persons engaging in voter registration activities pursuant to this section shall be required to
30	receive training approved by the State Board prior to engaging in such voter registration activities.
31	Each person shall sign a sworn affidavit on a form prescribed by the State Board attesting that he will
32	abide by all Virginia laws and rules regarding the registration of voters. When engaging in voter
33	registration activities, each person shall maintain a log of his registration activities. This log shall
34	include information as required by the State Board and shall be submitted with all completed
35	applications collected by such person. Each person shall include on a voter registration application the
36	identification number issued by the Department and, in the case of a volunteer or employee of a
37	third-party registration group, the identification number assigned to him by his group's organizer. No
38	application for registration shall be rejected for the failure of the third-party registration group to put
39	such identification number on the application.
40	D. No individual or group shall compensate its volunteers or employees on the basis of the number
41	of completed voter registration applications the volunteer or employee collects. No volunteer or
42	employee of an individual or group shall accept compensation based on the number of completed voter
43	registration applications he collects.
44	<i>E.</i> Whenever the Department of Elections, local electoral board, or general registrar's office furnishes
45	individuals registers an individual or groups multiple copies of the voter registration application group
46	as a third-party registration group, it shall provide accompanying instructions that contain a copy and
47	explanation of § 24.2-1002.01 and the penalty for destruction of, or failure to mail or deliver, voter
<b>48</b>	registration applications that have been signed. Any like instructions furnished to the public by whatever
49	means shall contain a copy and explanation of § 24.2-1002.01 and the penalty for destruction of, or
50	failure to mail or deliver, voter registration applications. When obtaining 25 or more voter registration
51	applications, such individuals or groups shall be required to register with and provide to the Department,
52	local electoral board, or general registrar's office such information as required by the Department. Such
53	individuals or agents representing a group shall be required to receive training as approved by the State
54	Board and sign a sworn affidavit on a form prescribed by the State Board attesting that such individuals
55	or organizations will abide by all Virginia laws and rules regarding the registration of voters.
56	No individual or group shall compensate its volunteers or employees on the basis of the number of
57	completed voter registration applications the volunteer or employee collects. No volunteer or employee
58	of an individual or group shall accept compensation based on the number of completed voter registration
