| 10       | § 46.2-816.1. Infliction of injury on vulnerable road users; penalty.                                     |
| 11       | A. As used in this section, "vulnerable road user" means a pedestrian or a person operating a             |
| 12       | bicycle, electric personal assistive mobility device, electric power-assisted bicycle, wheelchair or      |
| 13       | wheelchair conveyance, skateboard, roller or in-line skates, foot-scooter, or animal-drawn vehicle or     |
| 14       | riding an animal.   |
| 14<br>15 | B. Any person who, as a result of operating a motor vehicle in violation of § 46.2-802, 46.2-803,         |
| 16       | 46.2-804, 46.2-805, 46.2-806, 46.2-807, 46.2-812, 46.2-814, 46.2-816, 46.2-817, 46.2-818.1, 46.2-820,     |
