9	Whereas, in 2010 the General Assembly designated the Honor and Remember Flag as the
10	Commonwealth's emblem of the service and sacrifice of the brave men and women of the United States
11	Armed Forces who had given their lives in the line of duty; and
<b>12</b>	Whereas, since that designation there have been instances where the appropriateness for the display
13	of the Honor and Remember Flag was unclear; and
14	Whereas, there is a need to clarify when it is appropriate to display the Honor and Remember Flag
15	in light of its symbolic importance; now therefore

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. § 1. That in the absence of a directive from the Governor or the Director of the Department of General Services, the head of the state agency that controls any facility or building outside of Capitol Square may determine when to display the Honor and Remember Flag, provided that the Honor and Remember Flag that is displayed is (i) smaller in height and width than the flag of the United States

that is officially displayed at the building or facility and (ii) made in the United States.
