5 6 WHEREAS, Michael F. Kuhns will retire as president and chief executive officer of the Virginia 7 Peninsula Chamber of Commerce on April 1, 2018, after seven years of exemplary service and 8 leadership; and

9 WHEREAS, Michael "Mike" Kuhns earned a bachelor's degree from Marquette University and 10 served his country as a captain in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, a former employee of the Illinois-based economic development organization, the 11 Heartland Partnership, Mike Kuhns also served as a former president and chief executive officer of the 12 Greater Idaho Falls Chamber of Commerce and has worked as an organizational consultant to chambers 13 14 of commerce across the Commonwealth; and

15 WHEREAS, Mike Kuhns settled in Newport News in 2003 and was later named president and chief 16 executive officer of the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce in 2010; and

WHEREAS, under Mike Kuhns' able leadership, the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce 17 rebranded itself, worked to bolster its visibility in the region by increasing its number of annual events, 18 19 and engaged with governors, legislators, military commanders, and other prominent leaders; and

20 WHEREAS, a talented fiscal administrator, Mike Kuhns resolved the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of 21 Commerce's debts and established positive cash balances, equity, and six months of operating reserves; 22 and

23 WHEREAS, Mike Kuhns' other accomplishments include restructuring the Virginia Peninsula 24 Chamber of Commerce's Military Affairs Council, establishing an Annual Partnership Program, starting 25 the Virginia Peninsula Chamber Foundation to support nonprofits and local government initiatives, and creating the Peninsula Economic Resource Team, which brings together economic development directors 26 27 from across the region; and

28 WHEREAS, in addition to his leadership with the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce, Mike 29 Kuhns serves as vice chair of the Thomas Nelson Community College Board, co-chair of the Eustis 30 Civic Leaders Association, vice president of legislative affairs for the Langley Civic Leaders Association, and chairman of Friends of the Newport News Fire Department; and 31

WHEREAS, throughout his tenure with the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce, Mike Kuhns 32 33 has worked tirelessly to find solutions to business-related community issues and has won the respect of 34 his colleagues for his dedication, judgment, and excellent communication skills; and

35 WHEREAS, in his well-deserved retirement, Mike Kuhns plans to travel, enjoy visits with family 36 members, and devote more time to community service; now, therefore, be it

37 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 38 commend Michael F. Kuhns on his outstanding service to the community on the occasion of his 39 retirement as chief executive officer and president of the Virginia Peninsula Chamber of Commerce; 40 and, be it

41 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Michael F. Kuhns as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for his 42 impressive career accomplishments and best wishes for the future. 43
