11	WHEREAS, this nation has become deeply in debt as its expenditures have exceeded available
12	revenues so that the total federal public debt now exceeds \$20 trillion and continues to increase and is
13 14	of such great proportion that responsibility for its payment, with interest, will be passed to future, unborn generations of Americans to assume without their consent; and
14	WHEREAS, attempts to curtail federal spending, confine expenditures to available revenues, and
16	reduce the annual deficit have not been successful; and
17	WHEREAS, in recent years Congress has mandated the implementation of government programs by
18	the states without providing funding for all such programs and could continue to encroach on state
19	budgets as a means of balancing the federal budget; and
20	WHEREAS, the Constitution of Virginia provides for a balanced budget, and this provision has
21 22	reinforced the inherent fiscal common sense of spending only funds available and has contributed to the Commonwealth's outstanding reputation for sound fiscal management and policy; and
$\frac{22}{23}$	WHEREAS, efforts in Congress to amend the United States Constitution to add a balanced budget
24	requirement have not been successful; and
25	WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution grants to the states the right to initiate a
26	process of amending the Constitution through application by the legislatures of two-thirds of the several
27	states to the Congress, calling for an amendment convention; and
28 29	WHEREAS, the Congress is required by Article V to call such a convention upon receipt of such
30	applications from two-thirds of the states; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Commonwealth of Virginia
31	hereby apply to the Congress of the United States to call an amendment convention pursuant to Article
32	V of the United States Constitution for the purpose of proposing an amendment to the United States
33	Constitution that pertains to the subject of balancing the federal budget; and, be it
34	RESOLVED FURTHER, That this application is to be considered as covering the balanced budget
35 36	amendment provisions of the presently outstanding Article V balanced budget applications from other
30 37	states, including previously adopted applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, New
38	Hampshire, North Carolina, North Dakota, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee,
39	Texas, Utah, West Virginia, Wisconsin, and Wyoming, and shall be aggregated with those other
40	applications for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require the calling of a
41	convention; and, be it
42	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the other states be encouraged to make similar applications for an
43 44	amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That this application shall constitute a continuing application for such
45	amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution until the legislatures of
46	two-thirds of the states shall have made such applications and such convention shall have been called by
47	the Congress of the United States; and, be it
48	RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit copies of this resolution to the
49	President of the United States, the Speaker and the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives,
50 51	the President and the Clerk of the United States Senate, the members of the Virginia Congressional
51 52	Delegation, and the legislatures of each of the several states, attesting the adoption of this resolution by the Virginia General Assembly.
