4. Title: Method of execution; lethal injection drugs.

5. Summary: Eliminates the provision making the identities of (i) any pharmacy or outsourcing facility that enters into a contract with the Department of Corrections for the compounding of drugs necessary to carry out an execution by lethal injection, (ii) any officer or employee of such pharmacy or outsourcing facility, and (iii) any person or entity used by such pharmacy or outsourcing facility to facilitate the compounding of such drugs confidential, exempt from the Freedom of Information Act (Â§ 2.2-3700 et seq.), and not subject to discovery or introduction as evidence in any civil proceeding unless good cause is shown.
