**3. Committee:** Transportation.

**4. Title:** Electronic toll collection device monthly statements; fees.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits the Department of Transportation from charging monthly fees in connection with online monthly account statements for electronic toll collection devices.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Department of Transportation, the EZ Pass Virginia Program would have to absorb the cost for all patrons who opt to receive a monthly online statement. Online monthly statement fees are \$1 per month and currently generate \$27,000 per month, \$324,000 per year, as revenue for the EZ Pass Program used to offset operating costs. This does not account for any increase in the number of EZ Pass accounts which may occur due to new High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes facilities on I-66 and I-64.

Currently all detailed transaction information is available online for free and provides the same information as the pre-formatted statements.
