4. Title: Correctional officer survey upon resignation

5. Summary:

Current law requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to survey each correctional officer upon his/her resignation, termination, or reassignment to a position other than correctional officer for the purpose of evaluating employment conditions and factors that contribute to or impede the retention of correctional officers. The proposed legislation would require DOC to submit a report annually to the Governor and the General Assembly on the results of such surveys.
