**4. Title:** Dredged material siting; fast-track permitting program.

Summary:** This bill directs the Marine Resources Commission to adopt regulations to establish and implement a fast-track permitting program for the selection and use of appropriate sites for the disposal of dredged material no later than July 1, 2019. This bill further directs the MRC to provide an opportunity for public comment on such regulations prior to adoption.
