3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Workers' Compensation Commission; quorum

5. Summary: Provides that the commissioners of the Workers' Compensation Commission, for purposes of constituting a quorum, shall include any deputy commissioner or retired commissioner who is appointed or recalled, respectively, to fill a vacancy on the Commission.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. Indeterminate - see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Language in Item 474 P. 1. of HB 30, 2018 Session requires the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission (VWC) to reimburse the actual expenses incurred by a retired member who is temporarily recalled to service, excluding travel expenses, and a per diem of \$250 for each day the retired member actually sits. It is unknown how often the VWC will have to recall a retired member to fill a vacancy on the Commission; therefore, the costs incurred by the VWC cannot be determined.
