Summary:** Directs the State Board of Juvenile Justice to promulgate regulations and standards to include: 1) a suicide watch instrument and, 2) policies on the transportation of juvenile offenders to and from state correctional facilities, Department of Juvenile Justice facilities, local and regional jails, state and local pretrial and community-based probation service agencies, privately managed and operated local or regional detention homes or other secure facilities, and other juvenile detention facilities.
