1. Bill Number: HB1276

2. Patron: Garrett

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Commissioner of Highways; federal pilot programs.

5. Summary: This bill requires that the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) convene a work group to identify the implications of participating in a federal data collection pilot program or project involving six-axle tractor truck semitrailer combinations weighing up to 91,000 pounds and utilizing interstate highways. The agency is to file a report with its findings to the Governor and General Assembly by the first day of the 2019 General Assembly Session.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is not possible at this time to determine the costs to VDOT to convene the work group required by this legislation and complete a report on the work group's findings. Any such costs would need to be absorbed by the agency using existing resources.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: VDOT, Department of Motor Vehicles, Virginia State Police, localities.
