4. Title: Military surplus off-road motor vehicles; registration and operation on highways

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue a registration card and license plates for military surplus off-road motor vehicles, as defined in the bill. The bill authorizes the use of military surplus off-road motor vehicles for purposes similar to those authorized for antique motor vehicles. The bill establishes a process whereby such vehicles that meet certain standards can be used for general transportation purposes. The bill exempts military surplus off-road motor vehicles from emissions standards.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will incur minor costs for information systems programming to implement the bill. The costs will be, in part, offset by the \$50 fee the bill authorizes DMV to charge for permanent military surplus off-road motor vehicle plates.
