4. Title: Records of retail licensees

5. Summary: Establishes that electronic records of retail licensees may be stored off site, provided that such records are readily retrievable and available for electronic inspection by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (the Board) or its special agents at the licensed premises.

The bill provides that in the case that such electronic records are not readily available for electronic inspection on the licensed premises, the retail licensee may obtain Board approval, for good cause shown, to provide the records to a special agent of the Board within three business days after a request is made to inspect the records.
