4. Title: Marriage and family therapy; appraisal.

Summary: Provides that "marriage and family therapy" means the appraisal and treatment of cognitive, affective, or behavioral mental and emotional disorders within the context of marriage and family systems through the application of therapeutic and family systems theories and techniques and delivery of services to individuals, couples, and families, singularly or in groups, for the purpose of treating such disorders. Currently, "marriage and family therapy" means the assessment and treatment of such disorders.
