3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Display or sale of used motor vehicles; penalty

5. Summary: This bill provides that violations of the prohibition on the display or sale, or permitting the display or sale, of more than five used motor vehicles within any 12-month period on real property for the purpose of selling or advertising the sale of used motor vehicles by the owner or lessee is punishable as a Class 4 misdemeanor. The bill contains technical amendments.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The provisions of this bill represent only minimal impact to the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board (MVDB) and the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). DMV law enforcement and forms development staff will assist the MVDB with the creation of the required form. However, no additional resources will be needed for either agency to enforce the new provisions of this bill.

A person convicted of a Class 4 misdemeanor is subject to a fine of no more than \$250, which will be deposited to the Literary Fund. The amount of revenue that might be collected is indeterminate.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to SB 532.
