3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: Special license to hunt bear; fee.

5. Summary: This bill directs the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to establish a special license for hunting bear, deer, and turkey for a fee of \$23 for a resident age 16 or older and \$150 for a nonresident age 16 or older. This bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2019.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will result in an overall increase in revenue generated by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) from the sale of bear, deer, and turkey licenses.

Based on FY17 figures and the assumption that all license holders would purchase Bear Deer Turkey Licenses, DGIF has indicated that this bill would result in a net increase of \$747,810 in revenue for Nonresident License sales and a loss of \$424,287 for Resident License sales, resulting in an overall increase of \$323,523 in annual revenue. It is anticipated that revenue changes will be seen in FY2020.
