4. Title: State Board of Social Services; regulations related to staffing of assisted living facilities.

5. Summary: Board of Social Services; regulations related to staffing of assisted living facilities providing care for adults with serious cognitive impairments. Directs the State Board of Social Services to amend regulations governing staffing of assisted living facilities that provide care for adults with serious cognitive impairments to allow an exception to certain requirements for assisted living facilities that are licensed for 10 or fewer residents if no more than three of the residents have serious cognitive impairments. This bill has an emergency clause that puts this act in force from its passage. It also requires the Board of Social Services to promulgate regulations to implement the provisions of the act to be effective within 280 days of its enactment.
