4. Title: Allows for public comment on tuition and fee increases at public institutions of higher education

5. Summary: Prohibits the governing board of each public institution of higher education from approving an increase in undergraduate tuition or mandatory fees without providing students, any parent who has co-signed a student loan through the institution, and the public an opportunity to provide public comment at a board meeting at least 30 days prior to any vote on such an increase.

The institution must inform, by email, posting on the homepage of the institution's website, and in any student newspaper, at least 30 days prior to a meeting of the board. In addition, the institution must provide notice of the date and location of any vote on increases by similar methods at least 30 days prior to vote.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any additional costs incurred by the institutions of higher education as a result of the provisions of this legislation can be absorbed within current resources.
