**4. Title:** Department of Criminal Justice Services; definitions; law-enforcement officer.

**5. Summary:** Adds members of the investigations unit designated by the State Inspector General to investigate allegations of criminal behavior affecting the operations of a state or nonstate agency and employees with internal investigations authority at the Department of Corrections and the Department of Juvenile Justice to the definition of “law-enforcement officer.” The bill also exempts these individuals from coverage under the Line of Duty Act.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No state fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Virginia Retirement System (VRS) indicates that since this bill excludes these individuals from Line of Duty Act coverage, this legislation does not generate a fiscal impact.
