4. Title: Fine for operating vehicle with accumulated ice or snow.
5. Summary: Imposes a fine of $\$ 100$, and makes it a traffic infraction, to operate a vehicle with any amount of accumulated ice or snow on its exposed surfaces where it is possible that if the snow or ice should become dislodged from the vehicle, it may interfere with the safe operation of another vehicle, causing injury or property damage. The bill provides an exemption for a person operating an emergency vehicle; snow/ice removal vehicles/plows; or a vehicle operated during adverse weather conditions arising after operation of the vehicle began that result in the accumulation of snow or ice on such vehicle.

8. Fiscal Implications: Revenue from fines is deposited into the Literary Fund. The proposed legislation could result in additional revenue, however, it is not feasible to project the increase in revenue as a result of this legislation.
