4. **Title:** Close relative adoption.

5. **Summary:** Lowers from three years to two years the amount of time a child must have continuously resided with or been under the physical custody of the prospective close relative adoptive parent in order for the adoption proceeding to commence in circuit court and be exempt from the parental placement provisions.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** This bill does not have a fiscal impact. It reduces the amount of time a child must reside with a close relative before adoption proceedings can begin.
