**4. Title:** Agriculture; food and drink sanitary requirements; exception for companion animals in wineries.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides for dogs to be allowed inside or on the premises of or inside a licensed distillery, a licensed winery or farm winery, or a licensed brewery or farm brewery, except in any area used for the manufacture or storage of food products.
