5. Summary: Provides the Commissioner of Social Services with certain powers and duties related to the custody, storage, preservation, duplication, and certification of adoption files. The bill contains an emergency enactment clause.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill does not have a fiscal impact. It increases the Commissioner's authority over the storage/preservation and certification processes of adoption records and clarify that an agreement by adoptive and birth parents to exchange non-identifying information can only be signed at the time of adoption.
