**5. Summary:** This bill provides that a driver's license shall not be issued for a period of less than five years, unless otherwise provided by law. Current law provides that a driver's license shall not be issued for more than eight years.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill sets a floor for the minimum validity period of a license unless otherwise provided for by law. The Department of Motor Vehicles does not anticipate a fiscal impact to the state from this bill.
