**4. Title:** Registration and licensing of vehicles; payment of local taxes and fees

**5. Summary:** This bill clarifies that in localities in which the treasurer or director of finance has entered into an agreement with the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles (Commissioner) for the Commissioner to refuse to issue or renew vehicle registrations for persons with certain delinquent taxes or fees, an applicant may be issued an initial 90-day registration for a vehicle purchased subsequent to the onset of enforcement action, allowing the applicant time to satisfy all requirements.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See Item #8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles would incur and would absorb one-time costs of \$89,908 for information systems programming to implement the bill.
