**5. Summary:** Adds two nonlegislative citizen members to the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects. This bill also removes the provisions requiring the Council of Certified Interior Designers submit nominations for each interior designer vacancy.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this bill will result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR). The Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects (APELSCIDLA) reimburses members for travel expenses incurred when attending board meetings. The annual cost for two additional Board members is approximately \$1,500. No other fiscal impacts are anticipated as it is anticipated that this bill will not impact APELSCIDLA fees. DPOR is a nongeneral fund agency supported with application and licensing fees. The APELSCIDLA Board funds its operational costs plus a proportionate share of agency operating expenses.
