**5. Summary:** Requires the Commissioner of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS) to report annually by December 1 to the Governor and the General Assembly on the Department's activities related to suicide prevention across the lifespan.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill codifies current practice, with the exception that DBHDS must now complete an annual report on departmental activities related to suicide prevention.
