3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Delinquent children; issuance of learner's permits

5. Summary: This bill authorizes a court to authorize the issuance of a learner's permit to a minor adjudicated delinquent of an offense that results in a denial of the minor's privilege to operate a motor vehicle. The bill provides that the court may impose additional restrictions on the minor's operation of a motor vehicle pursuant to a learner's permit.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will incur costs estimated at \$74,816 to make the necessary changes to the agency's information systems in order to issue restricted learner's permits. These costs will be absorbed within existing resources. It is assumed that the restrictions will be limited to those available for adult restricted driving credentials. If DMV must create new restrictions, then the agency's costs would rise.
