**4. Title:** Inspections prior to sale; exception; certain special orders

**5. Summary:** This bill exempts from the requirement that motor vehicles be inspected prior to retail sale transactions a motor vehicle that is sold on the basis of a special order placed by or with a dealer who makes modifications to such vehicle prior to delivery to the first retail customer. The bill expands the existing exception for dealers who order from a manufacturer outside the Commonwealth on behalf of a nonresident of the Commonwealth to include orders made with another dealer outside the Commonwealth. The bill contains a technical amendment.
