3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Inspections prior to sale; exception; certain special orders

5. Summary: This bill exempts from the requirement that motor vehicles be inspected prior to retail sale transactions a motor vehicle that is sold on the basis of a special order placed by or with a dealer or manufacturer who makes modifications to such vehicle prior to delivery to the first retail customer. The bill expands the existing exception for dealers who order from a manufacturer outside the Commonwealth on behalf of a nonresident of the Commonwealth to include orders made with another dealer outside the Commonwealth. The bill contains a technical amendment.
